



### ***Code of Conduct for Participants***

Derbyshire Sport is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of participants in its activities and programmes. The organisation believes that it is important that sports participants, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the activities of Derbyshire Sport should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Therefore, they are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the activities of Derbyshire Sport through the appropriate channels.

As a participant in Derbyshire Sport activities you are expected to abide by the following rules:

- Do the best you can.
- Treat people as you would wish to be treated on and off the pitch, court or stage - don't bully or intimidate others.
- Play by the rules.
- Control your temper - never use bad language.
- Respect and listen to the Officials / Judges - their decision is final.
- Co-operate with your Team Manager / Coach / Leader.
- Make sure you wear the right kit, and keep yourself and others safe.
- Pay any fees for sessions or events promptly.
- Do not smoke during Derbyshire Sport sessions or events.
- Do not consume alcohol or drugs during Derbyshire Sport sessions or events.

**Failure to comply with the codes may result in further action being taken by Derbyshire Sport including exclusion from the event or activity.**

**A breach of the codes can result in disciplinary measures being invoked or ultimately in legal action.**
