



Code of Conduct for Team Leaders, Parents & Supporter

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below. As a Team Leader / parent / supporter at Derbyshire Sport events / activities you are expected to:

- Encourage participants to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with Officials / Judges.
- Help participants to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Set a good example by applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a participant for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept the decisions of Officials / Judges.
- Control your temper - never use bad language.

Failure to comply with the codes may result in further action being taken by Derbyshire Sport including exclusion from the event or activity.

A breach of the codes can result in one or more of the following measures - having 'time out', being taken out of a game/competition, informing parents/carers, being asked to leave the site/venue and suspension from a league, competition or event. Serious breaches may also involve legal action.
