A team from Derbyshire's Kirk Hallam Community Technology College took second place at the Aviva Sportshall East Midlands Regional Secondary Final.

The Year 7 Girls team missed out on the top spot by just two points, in what was a closely-run contest at Loughborough University on April 21.

The Year 7 Boys team, from Belper School, took fourth place in their competition at the same event.

Both teams had qualified to compete after winning the East Midlands Airport Derbyshire Year 7 Sportshall Athletics Finals last month.

South Derbyshire pupils to take starring role at international football match
