Thousands of teenagers and young adults across Derbyshire are to benefit from a new sports programme that aims to fulfil the legacy promise made by Seb Coe in Singapore in 2005.



Sportivate will give 14 to 25-year-olds the chance to receive six to eight weeks of coaching in a sport of their choice. Thanks to £565,640 of Lottery investment in Derbyshire at least 5,303 local people will be able to take part in activities such as judo, boxing, gymnastics, boccia, Zumba and other fitness-based sessions.

Focus on Funding

Derbyshire County Council – Community Action Grants Scheme

Community groups, voluntary groups, charities, social enterprises and sports clubs within Derbyshire can apply for grants of up to £1,000 to help with projects that improve community life within Derbyshire.

Projects must identify a local need, take place within Derbyshire and achieve one or more of the following key priorities from the Council's plan "Derbyshire – Leading the Way" which include:

- Working with local communities to help them flourish
- Giving children the best start in life
- Helping local people achieve their full potential
- Encouraging healthy, active and rewarding lifestyles

Funding will be available for a wide range of different projects including:

- Play or sports equipment
- An event for teenagers

- A sporting event
- Transport or training

The fund will not support running costs and ongoing staff costs.

There will be seven funding rounds before the scheme ends December 14, 2012. The first deadline for applications is July 29, 2011. [Read more](#)
