#### Bid to bring Olympic Torch Relay to Derbyshire

Derbyshire could shine in the run up to the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games if a bid to bring the Olympic Flame to the county is successful.

In the lead up to The Games, the Torch Relay will travel the length and breadth of the country, and a bid to make sure Derbyshire is included in the route is currently being put together.

Representatives from the worlds of sport, business, culture and tourism gathered for a workshop to discuss where within the county the Torch Relay should pass, and how best to engage communities across the county in the event.

#### Sport England and JustGiving partnership aims to bring extra £22m into grassroots sport

Sport England and JustGiving have announced a campaign to bring an extra £22m into grassroots sport over the next five years through a new partnership called JustGiving for Sports Clubs.

JustGiving for Sports Clubs will help sports club members to raise more money, and claim Gift Aid, using the same tools as the biggest charities in the UK. JustGiving have dropped their subscription fees – worth £180 per year for every club - for all Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs).

### Wins for Kirk Hallam and Belper schools at East Midlands Airport Derbyshire Year 7 Sportshall Athletics Finals

An exciting East Midlands Airport Derbyshire Year 7 Sportshall Athletics Finals saw teams from Kirk Hallam Community Technology College and Belper School take the winners' trophies.

Just two points separated the top two boys' teams, with Belper School from Amber Valley winning through with 262 points and Lees Brook Community Sports College from Derby East just behind with 260 points. In third place was Brookfield Community School, from Chesterfield, with 256 points.

Meanwhile in the girls' competition Kirk Hallam Community Technology College from Erewash pipped St Mary's Catholic High School from Chesterfield to the post, finishing the competition on 285 points and 282 points respectively. Dronfield Henry Fanshawe School from North East Derbyshire took third place with 255 points.

The winning Boys and Girls teams will now progress to the Aviva Sportshall East Midlands Regional Final at Loughborough University next month.

Sport England Active Universities Fund

Sport England has just launched its latest Themed Round. The Active Universities Fund will open on March 29, with Stage 1 applications to be submitted by June 23.

The grant programme aims to raise sports participation through addressing specific barriers to participation faced by students enrolled on higher education courses at universities in England.

Applications must be for £10,001 or over although there is no maximum amount set, with a total of £10m available for this Fund.
