Competition Manager Programme launched in Derbyshire

Double Commonwealth Gold medal winner and former world record holder over 5000 metres, David Moorcroft OBE, launched Derbyshire's Competition Manager Programme at the Derbyshire Sport Conference.

There it was announced that an additional £649,000 has been pledged for school sport in Derbyshire.

The money – from the Department for Children, Schools and Families via the Youth Sport Trust – will be coming into Derbyshire over the next three years to provide a boost to the promotion of sport in schools and to encourage more young people to become involved in a wider range of inter-school sport activities.

During the first months in post the existing Competition Manager team has begun to be involved with the review of the Derbyshire Schools Sports Association (DSSA), which is creating an exciting new environment for competitive school sport in Derbyshire.

As competition within and between schools becomes a greater priority for national Government so the need to provide the right infrastructure within Derbyshire assumes ever greater importance. In light of this the DSSA Executive Group took the decision in early 2007 to begin a process of review, which is now coming towards its conclusion.

However, additional funding from April 2008 to March 2011, announced in December 2007, will see the team expand with the addition of two further
