## Reports from the Districts

### Erewash

For the first time we are having two Girls Kwik festivals and two boys u9 Kwik festivals. There is a Senior Sunday Cricket league of 6 local teams and also have a Senior Evening League of 10 teams

### North Derbyshire

The news from North Derbyshire is that they are running the local youth league with 15 clubs taking part and they have entered 38 teams at Kwik, U11 hardball, U12, U13, U15 & U17.

### Derby City

**Women's Cricket:** Derby Women have a contract with Muggington CC to provide them with a base for playing matches. They will be going into Littleover Community School to do girls coaching and will set up with Derby Congs CC to promote girls cricket.

**Disability Cricket:** Derbyshire now has a disability cricket team based at Darley Abbey. This is for players of all ages with a range of disabilities and learning difficulties. Funding has been obtained to buy equipment and to fund umpires and scorers. County games have been arranged with Nottinghamshire and Cheshire and it is hoped to arrange other games on top of this.

**Sports Leadership Courses:** These are being run at Mackworth and it is hoped that the District can pick up some volunteers from this to assist in local clubs.

### Amber Valley

The Association has concentrated on Youth Development which has come a long way during the last couple of years. The members agreed that AVCA needed to provide a more professional look to the team by the provision of caps and shirts so as to create a positive identity for Amber Valley players. Additional funding has allowed the group to secure District Cricket in Amber Valley until March 2008. The Derbyshire Community Foundation funded a £900 grant, has invited AVCA to attend a photo-shoot which is to be part of their new promotional calendar.

## High Peak

Cricket in the High Peak is in a buoyant state with the members of the Derbyshire and Cheshire League all running four junior sides and four Clubs are currently running a Ladies side and a Under 9's league has been suggested.

## Derbyshire Dales

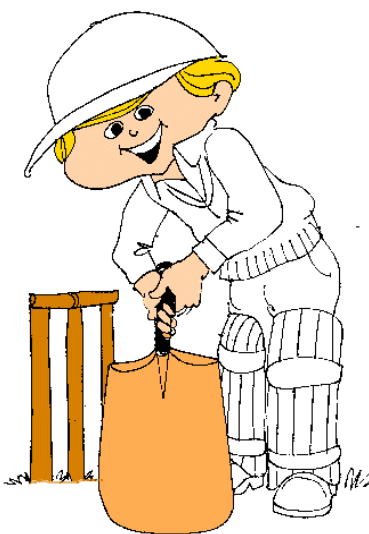
