



Equality Audit 2006 Report

'Partners working together to improve the lives of the people in Derbyshire through sport and active recreation.'

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Introduction

The aim of Derbyshire Sport is to make sport and active recreation equally accessible to all sections of the community.

In order to monitor how well our current policies and practices are achieving this aim, we invited people who worked for and with Derbyshire Sport to complete a profile audit.

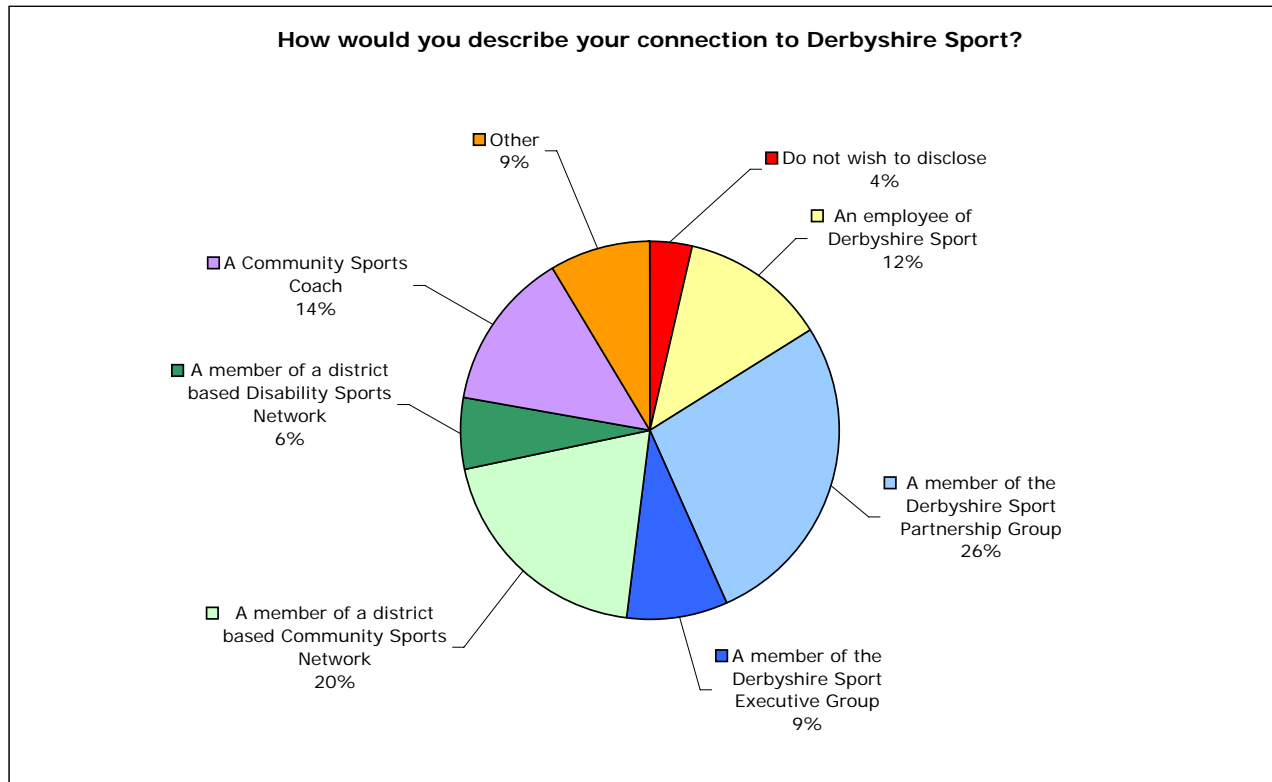
Respondents were not asked to identify themselves. In addition, they had the option not to complete sections that they felt were inappropriate or may help to identify them.

All information collected is to be kept confidential and only aggregated results appear in this document.

The outcomes of this audit will feed directly into a Derbyshire Sport Equality Action Plan to improve our performance in this area.

In excess of 70 responses were received from a wide range of respondents.

Question 1: How would you describe your connection to Derbyshire Sport?

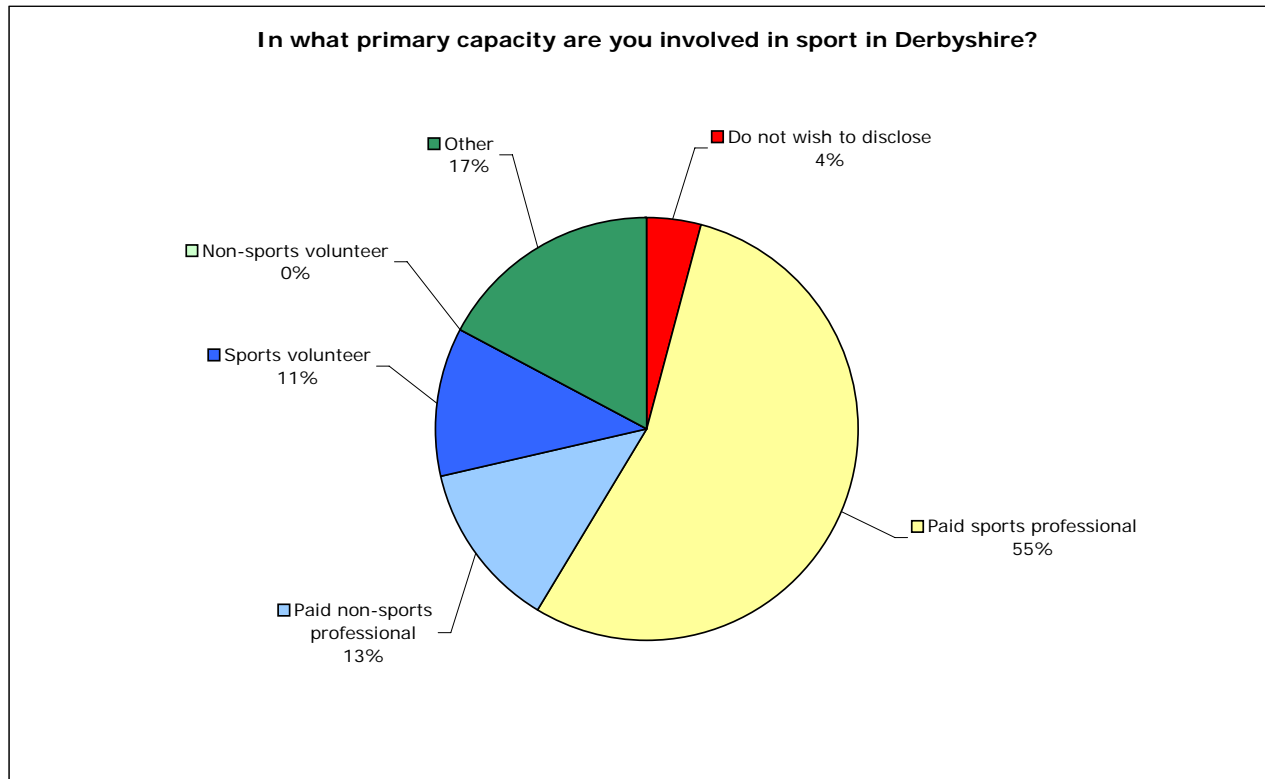


The first question was “How would you describe your connection to Derbyshire Sport”.

Some respondents specified multiple connections to Derbyshire Sport (e.g. some worked as a Community Sports Network however were also a member of a Disability Sports Network).

Most respondents specified that they were a member of the Derbyshire Sport Partnership Group (a total of 26%), closely followed by members of a district based Community Sports Network (a total of 20%).

Question 2: In what primary capacity are you involved in sport in Derbyshire?



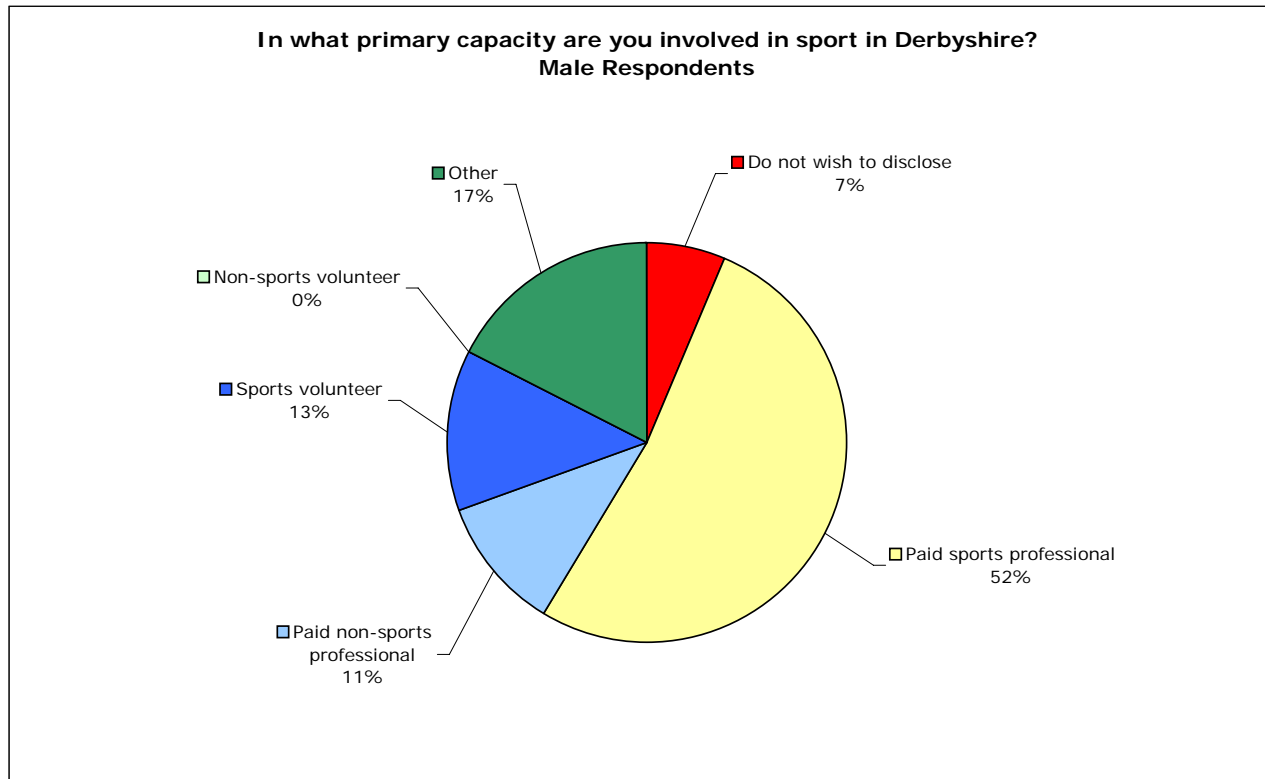
The second question asked respondents in what primary capacity are they involved in sport in Derbyshire.

55% of respondents were 'paid sports professionals'. There was then a fairly equal share of 'paid non-sports professionals', 'sports volunteers' and 'other'.

4% of respondents didn't want to disclose the information. 0% of respondents were 'non-sports volunteers'.

We can then break this down by gender.

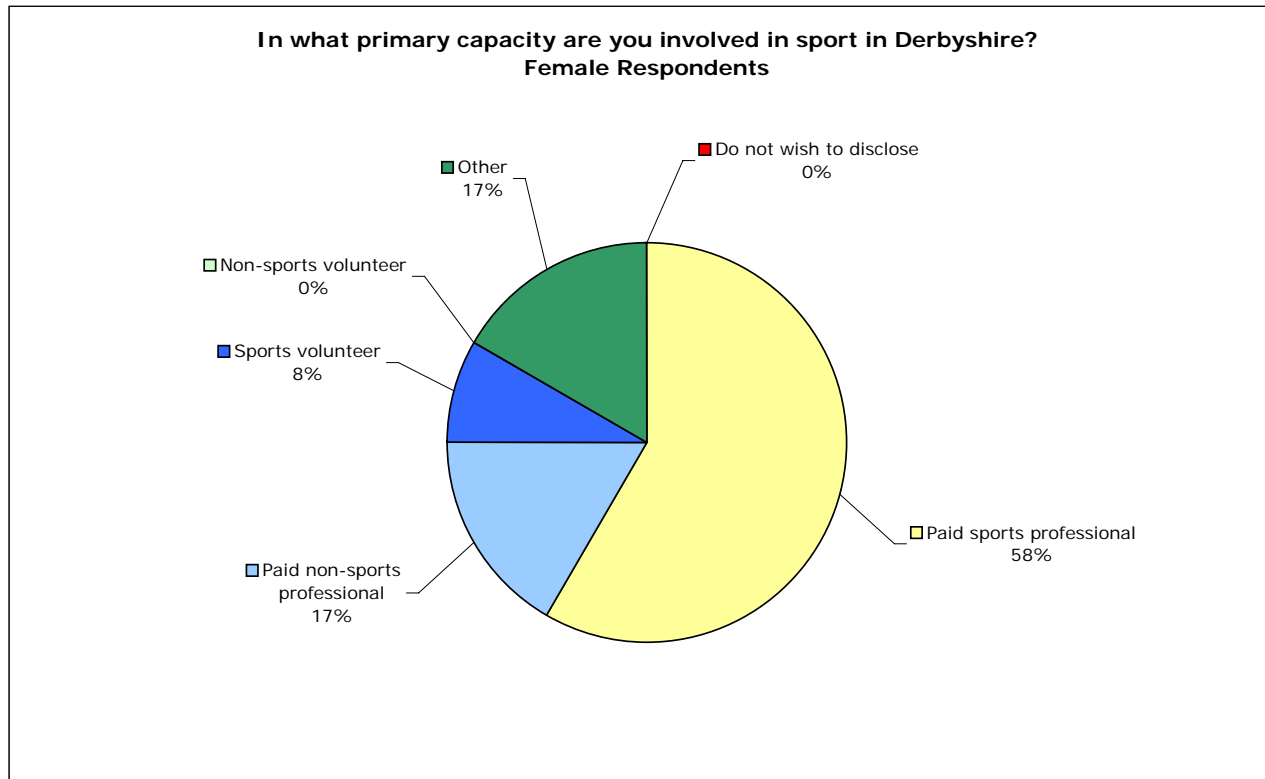
Question 2: Gender Breakdown – male respondents



52% of male respondents were 'paid sports professionals'. There was then a fairly equal share of 'paid non-sports professionals', 'sports volunteers' and 'other'.

7% of male respondents didn't want to disclose the information. 0% of respondents were 'non-sports volunteers'.

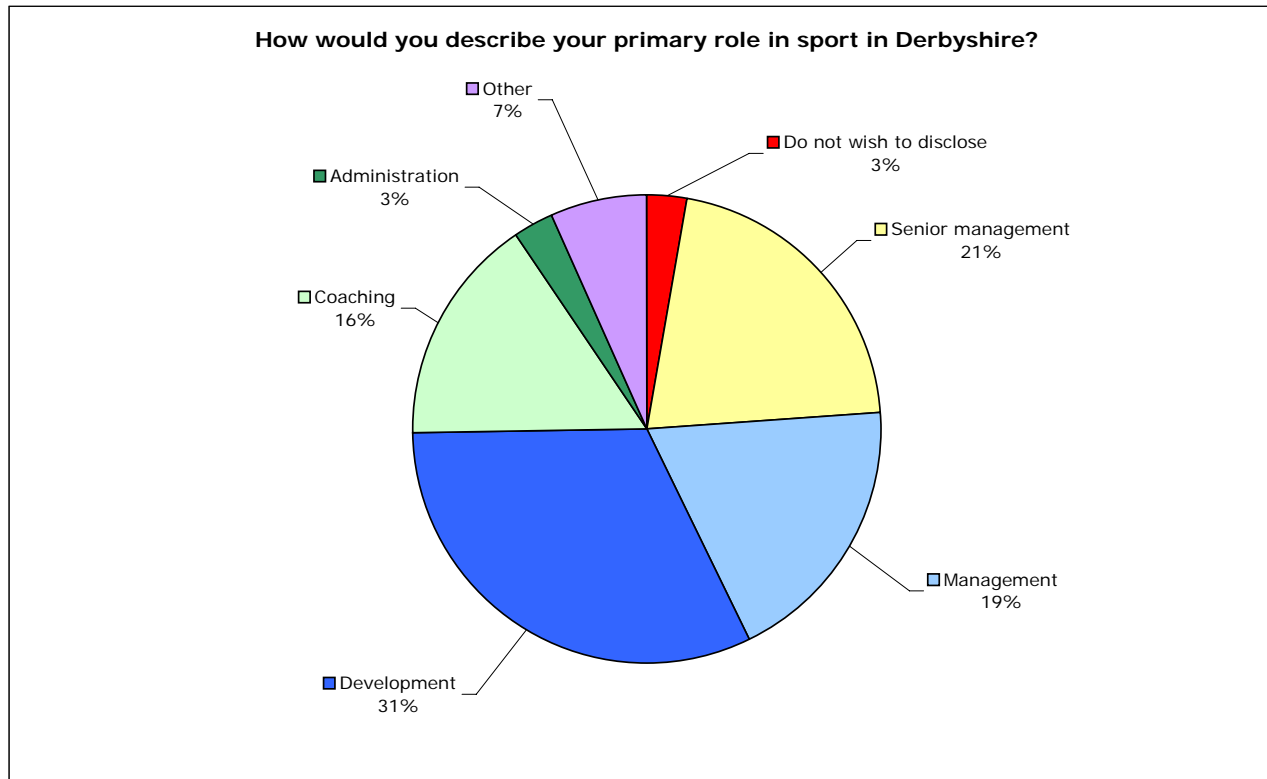
Question 2: Gender Breakdown – female respondents



58% of female respondents were 'paid sports professionals'. There was then a fairly equal share of 'paid non-sports professionals' and 'other'.

8% of female respondents were 'sports volunteers'.

Question 3: How would you describe your primary role in sport in Derbyshire?



The third question was 'how would you describe your primary role in sport in Derbyshire'.

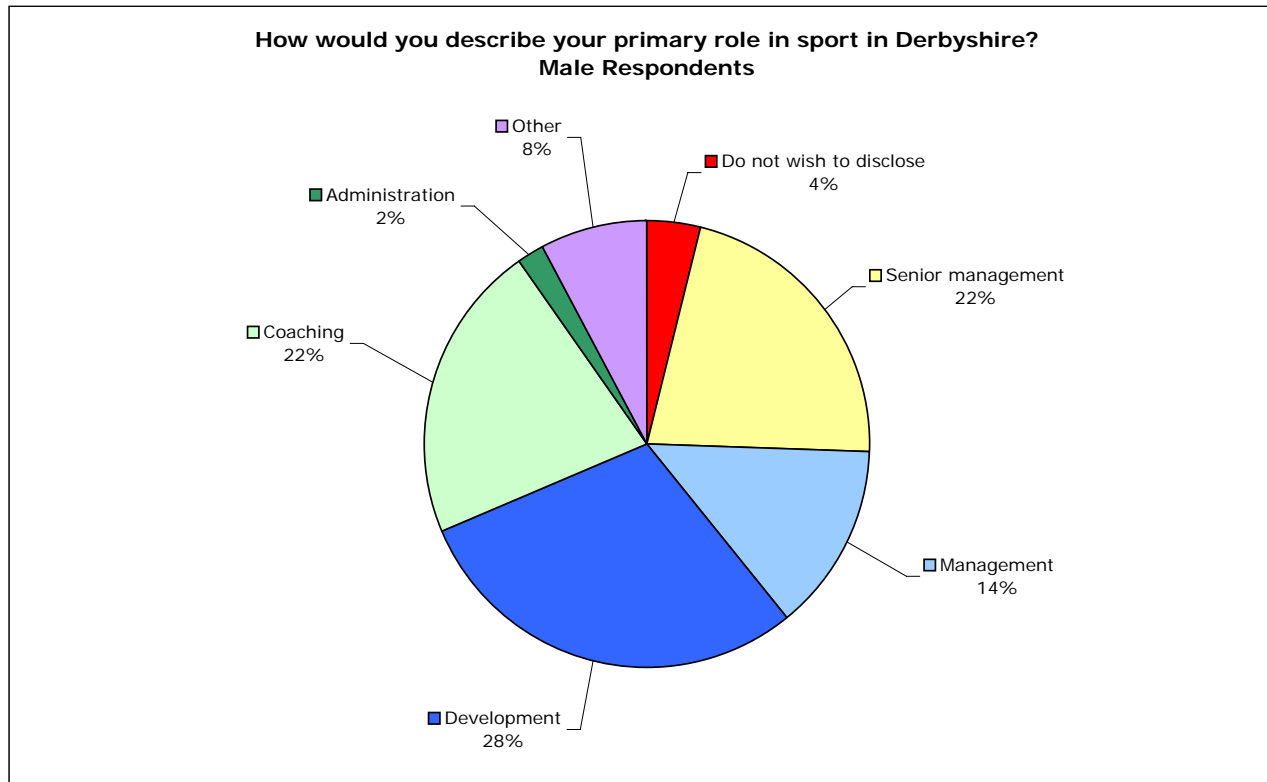
31% of respondents were involved in Development, 19% were management and 21% senior management.

Coaching, administration and other were 16, 3, and 7 percentages respectively.

3% of respondents felt that they didn't want to disclose the information.

We can then break this down by gender.

Question 3: Gender Breakdown – male respondents

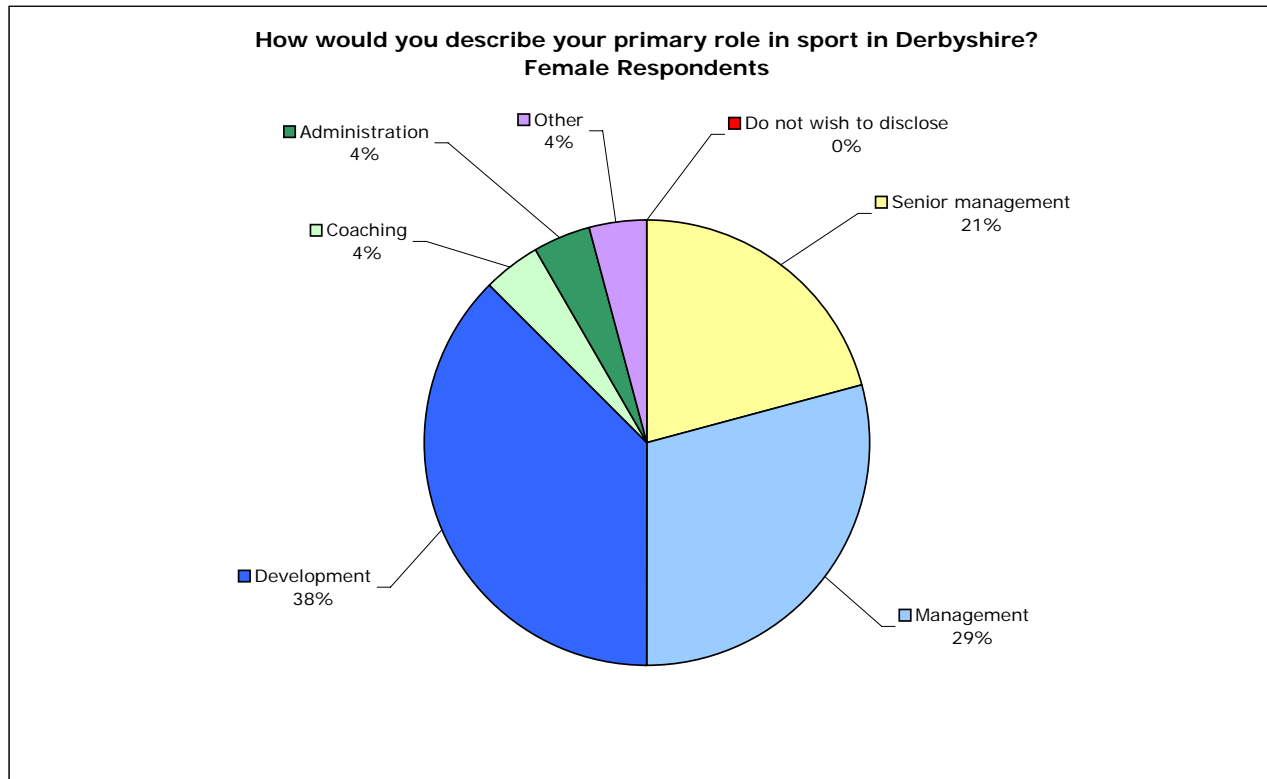


28% of male respondents were involved in Development, 14% were management and 22% senior management.

Coaching, administration and other were 22, 2, and 8 percentages respectively.

4% of male respondents felt that they didn't want to disclose the information.

Question 3: Gender Breakdown – female respondents

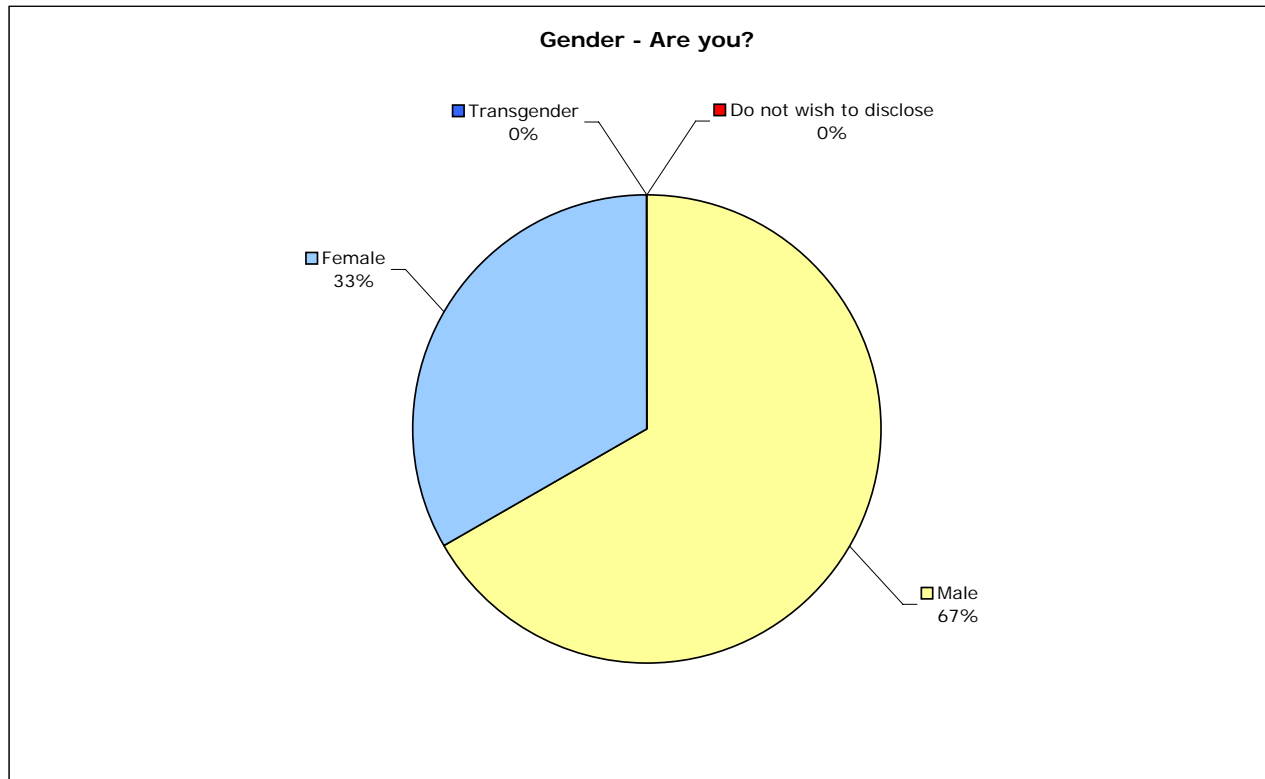


38% of female respondents were involved in Development, 29% were management and 21% senior management.

Coaching, administration and other were 4, 4, and 4 percentages respectively.

0% of female respondents felt that they didn't want to disclose the information.

Question 4: Gender - Are you?

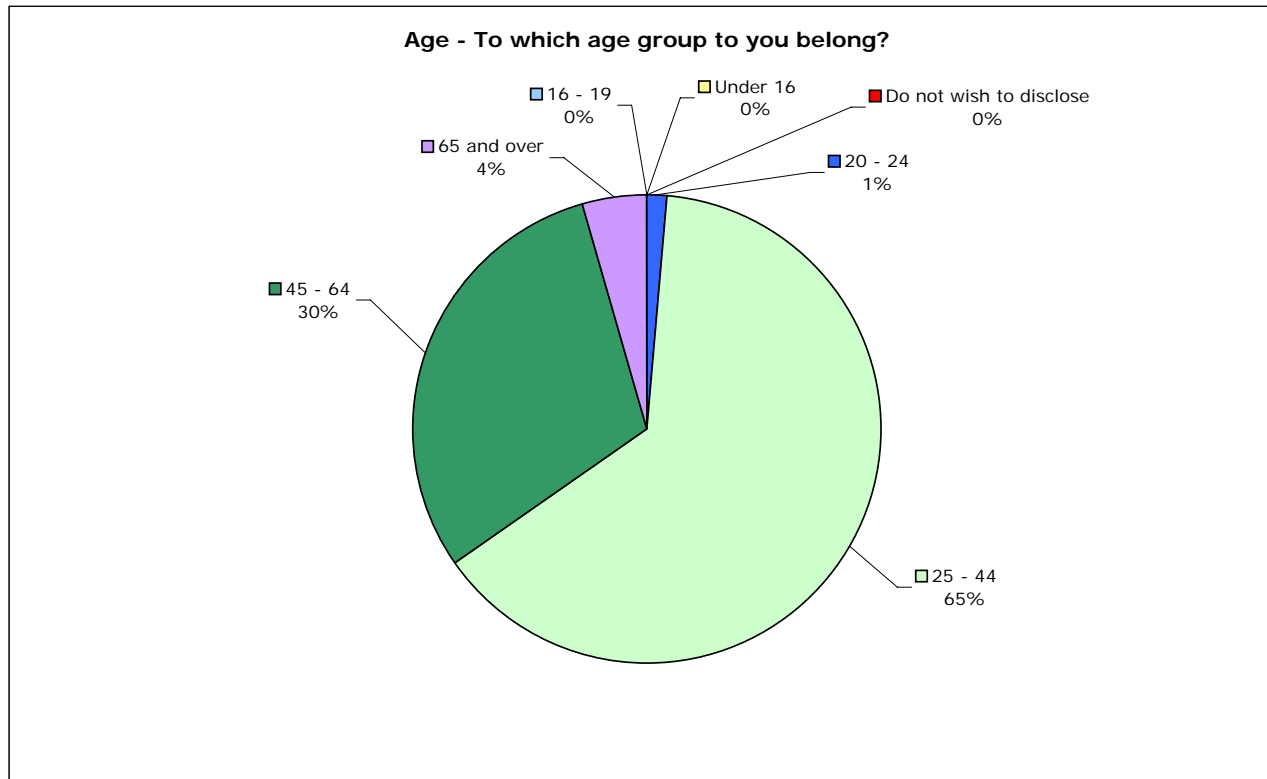


The fourth question asked respondents what gender they were.

67% of respondents were male, 33% were female.

0% of respondents specified transgender, and 0% did not wish to disclose their gender.

Question 5: Age - To which age group to you belong?



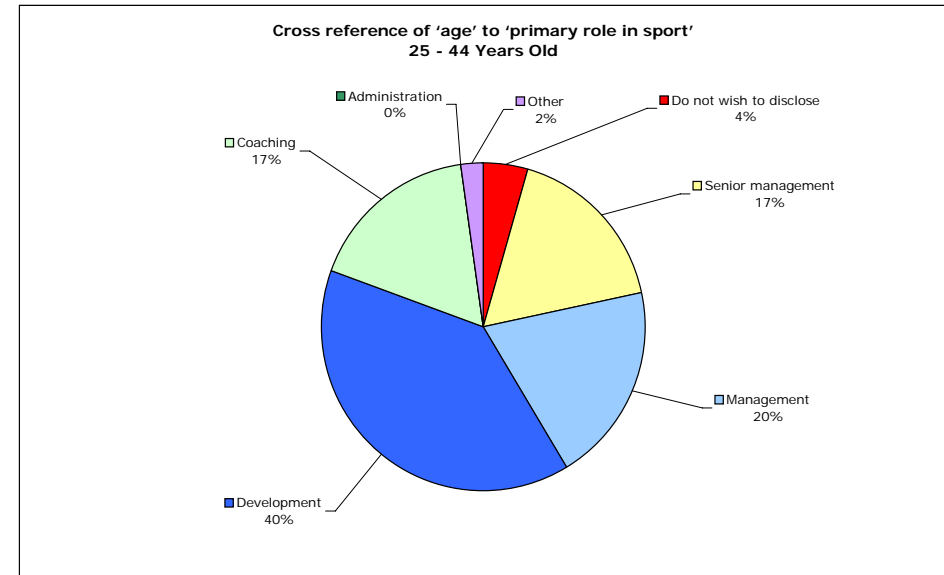
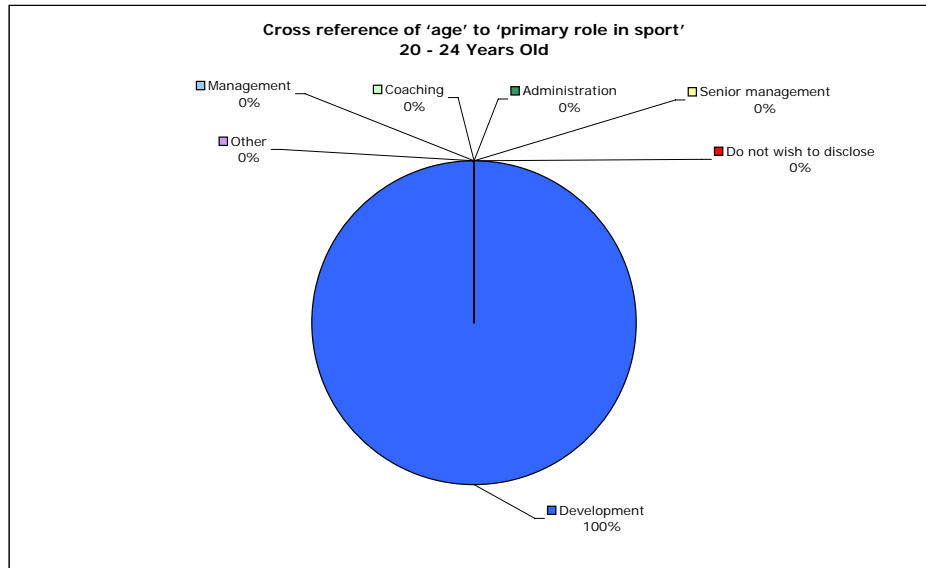
Respondents were then asked to which age group they belonged.

65% specified that they were aged from 25-44 years old. This was followed by 45-64 at 30%. 65 and over made up 5% and finally 20-24 made up 4%

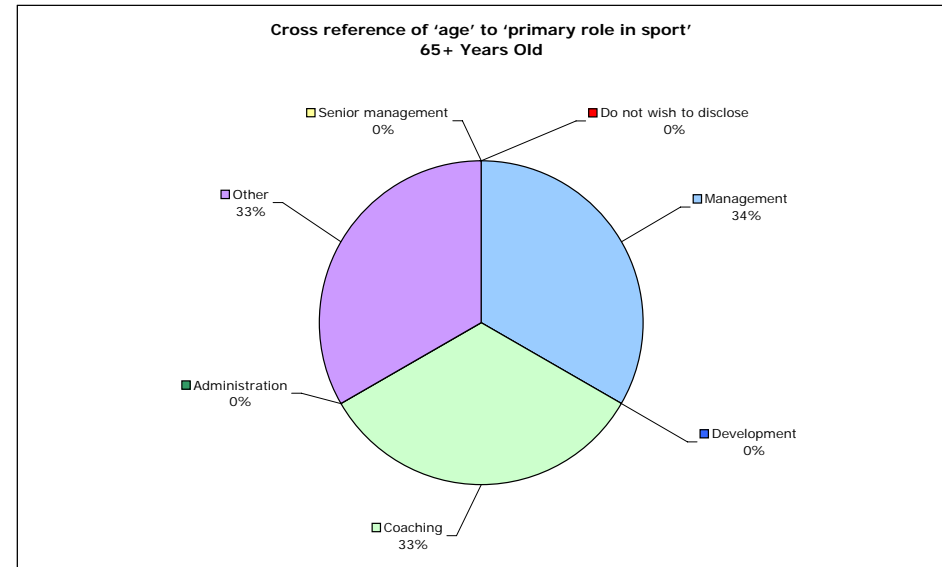
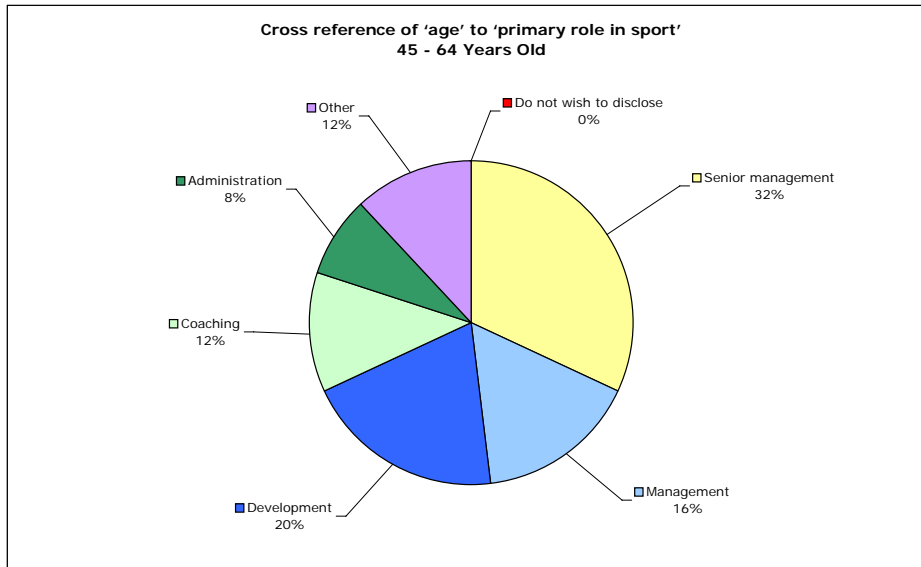
There were no under 16, and no 16-19 year olds. Similarly 0% did not wish to disclose this information.

We can cross reference 'age' to 'primary role in sport'.

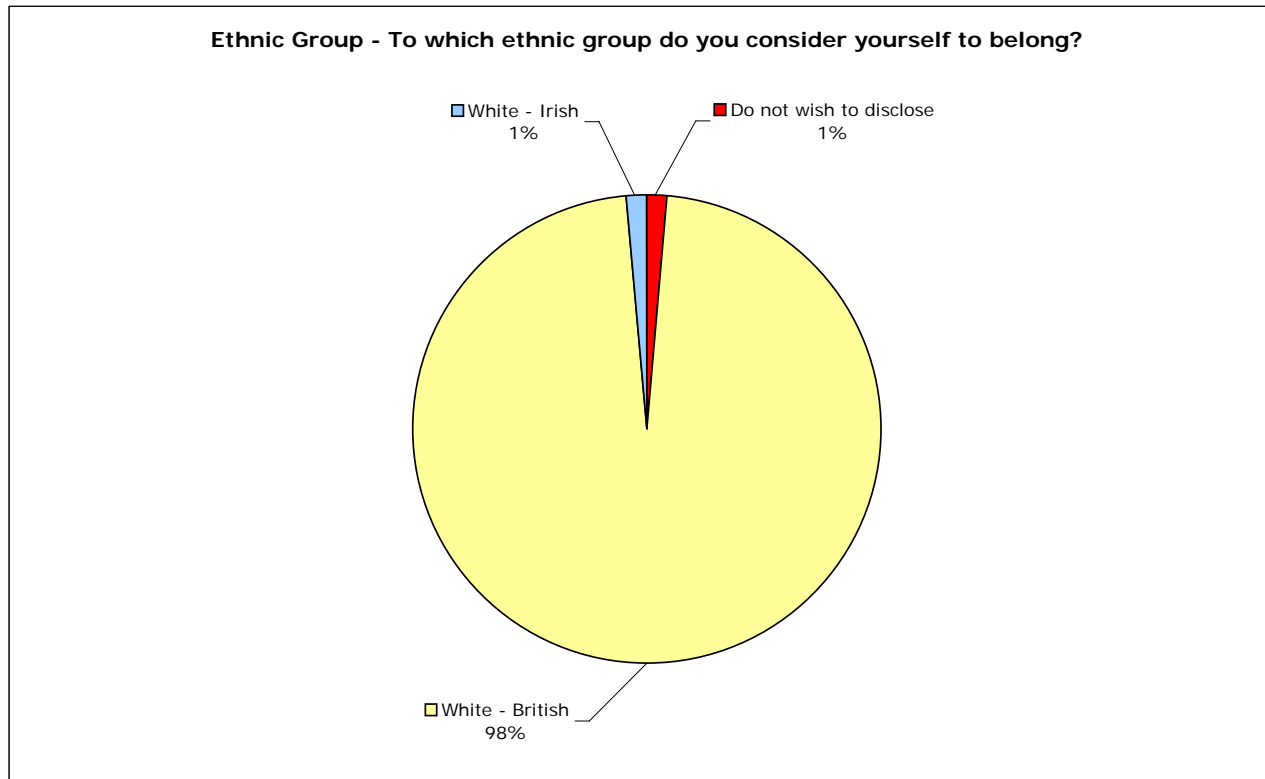
Question 5: Cross reference of 'age' to 'primary role in sport'

Question 6: Ethnic Group - To which ethnic group do you consider yourself to belong?

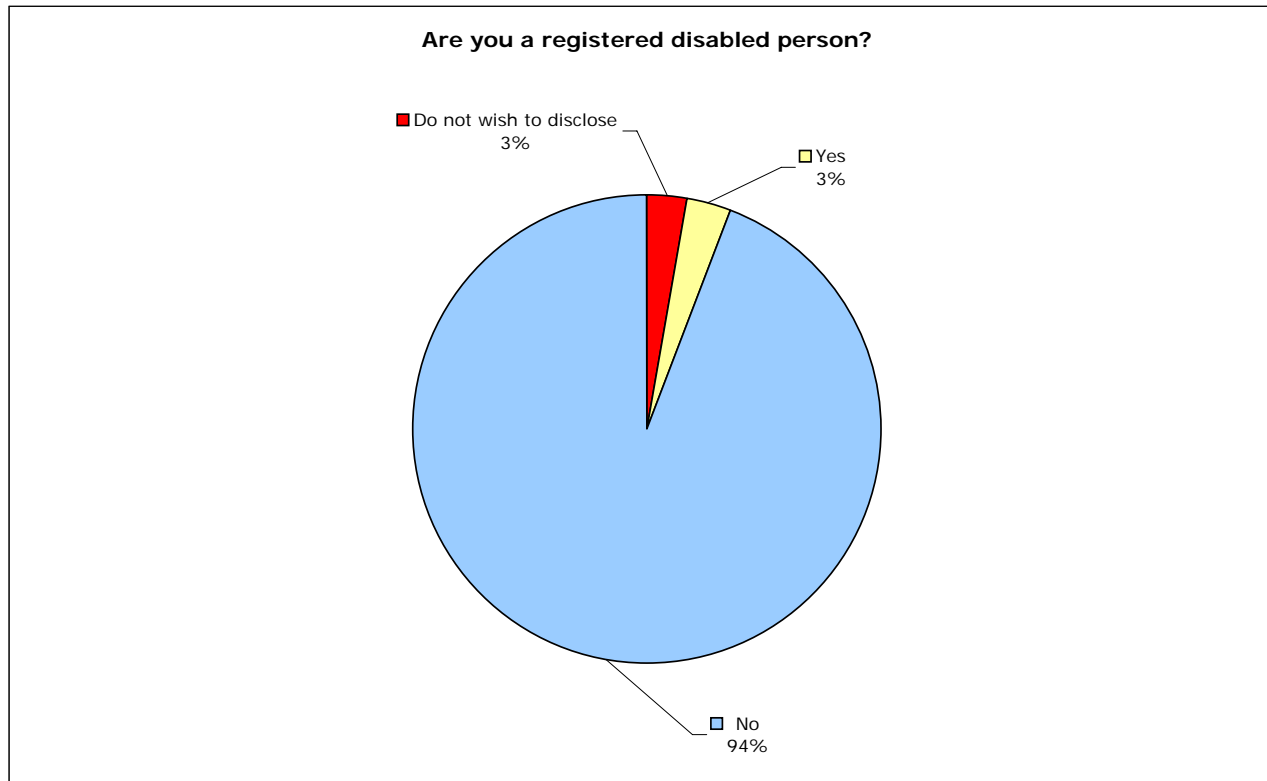


There were a total of 17 options for respondents to specify what ethnic group they belonged to. These were:

- Do not wish to disclose
- White - British
- White - Irish
- Any other white background
- Mixed - White and Black Caribbean
- Mixed - White and Black African
- Mixed - White and Asian
- Any other mixed background
- Asian or Asian British - Indian
- Asian or Asian British - Pakistani
- Asian or Asian British - Bangladeshi
- Any other Asian background
- Black or Black British - Caribbean
- Black or Black British - African
- Any other Black background
- Chinese
- Any other ethnic group

However, 98% of respondents were 'White British'. 1% of respondents specified 'White - Irish', and 1% didn't want to disclose their ethnicity.

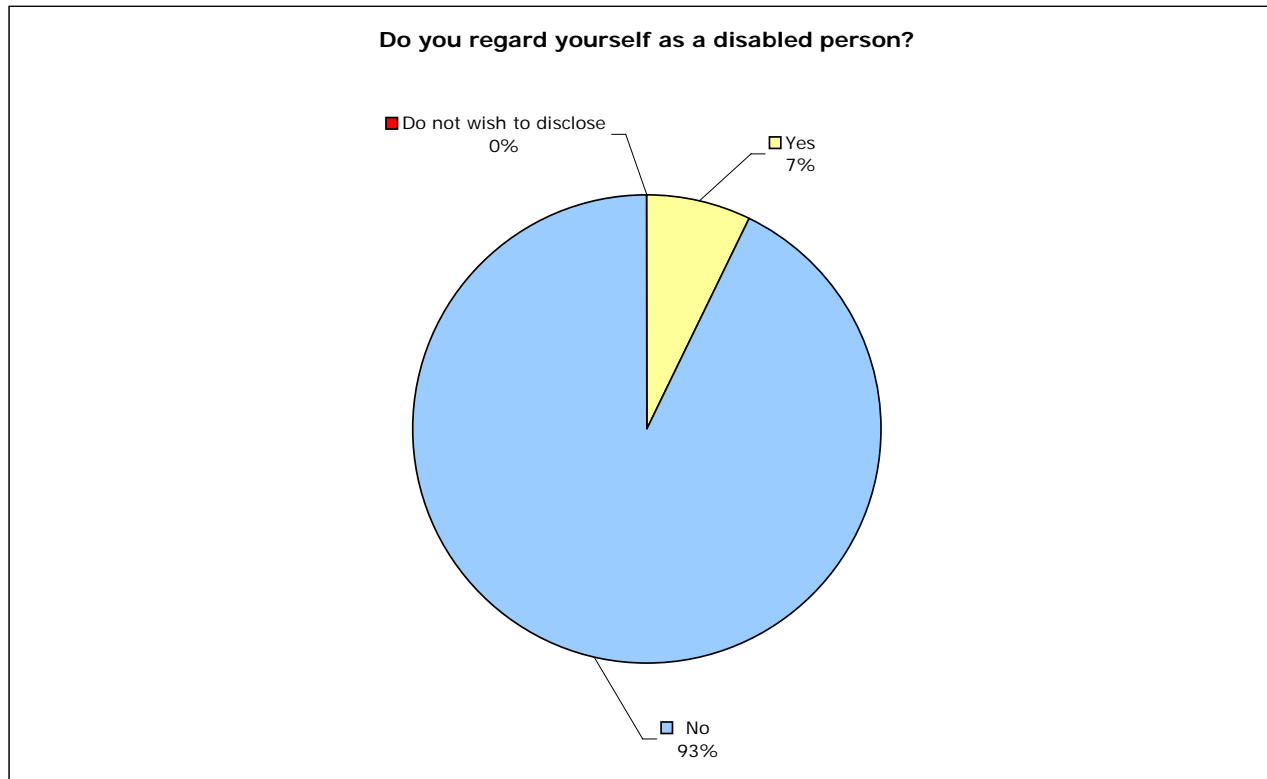
Question 7: Are you a registered disabled person?



Question 7 asked respondents if they were a registered disabled person.

94% specified that they were not a registered disabled person. 3% did not wish to disclose this information, and 3% said that yes, they were registered disabled.

Question 8: Do you regard yourself as a disabled person?

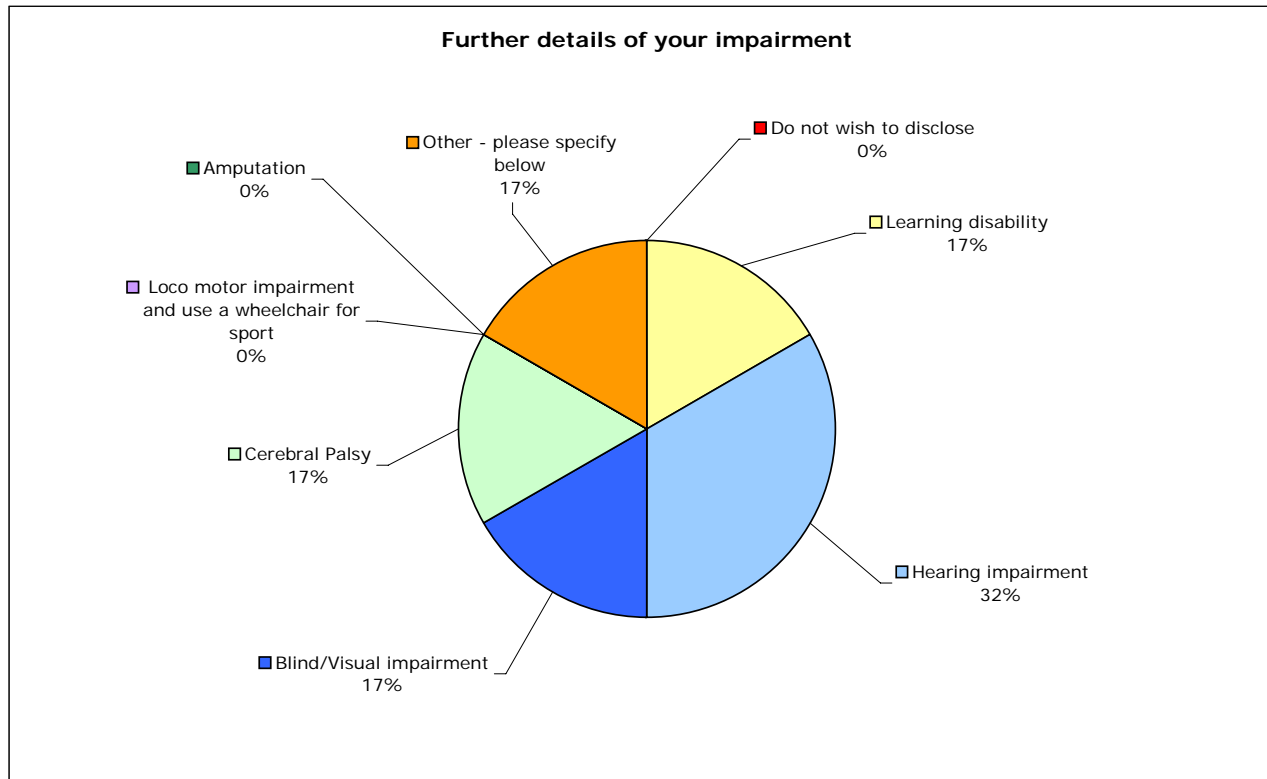


Question 8 expanded on the previous question, asking respondents if they regarded themselves as a disabled person.

93% specified that they did not regard themselves as being disabled. The remaining 7% of respondents did regard themselves as being disabled.

0% of respondents did not wish to disclose this information.

Question 9: Please give further details of your impairment

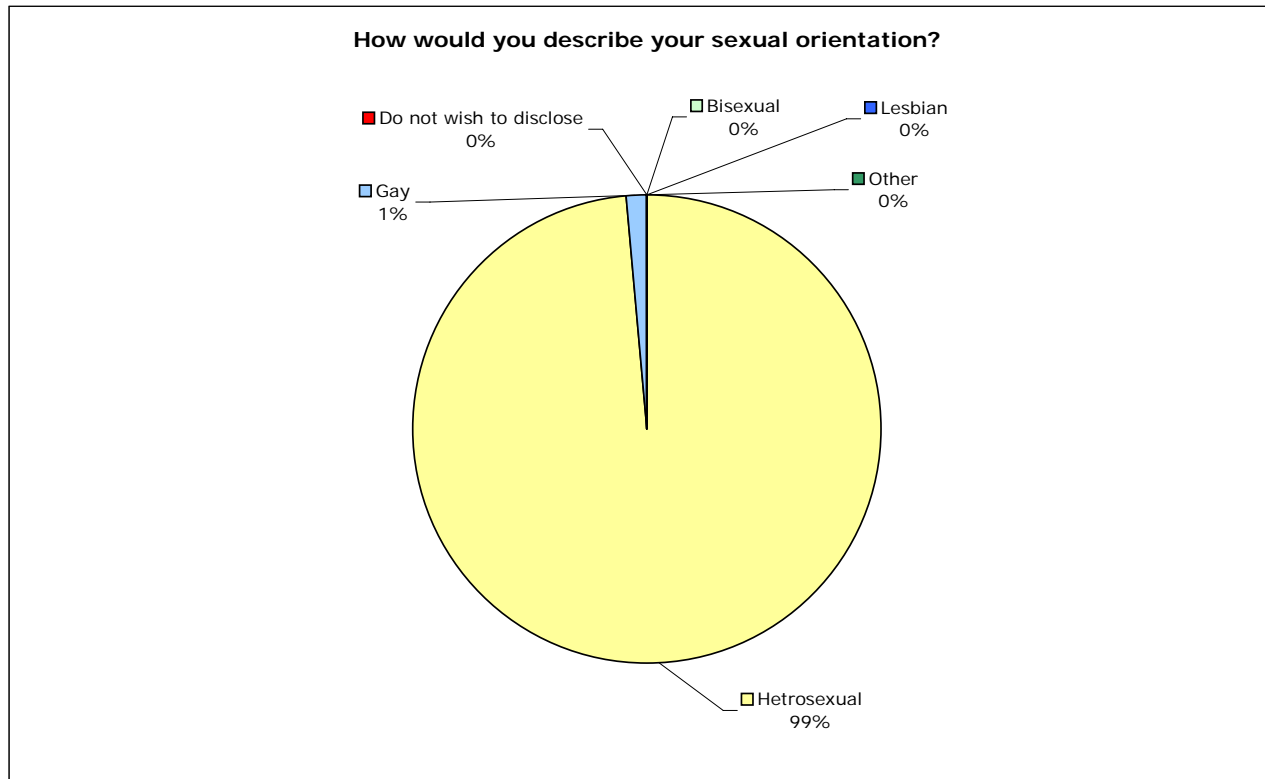


Question 9 asked respondents who had specified that they had a disability to specify what type of disability they have.

Of those that identified that they did have a disability, 32% specified that they had a hearing impairment.

17% specified that they had a learning disability, 17% specified blind/visual impairment, 17% cerebral palsy and 17% specified 'other'.

Question 10: How would you describe your sexual orientation?



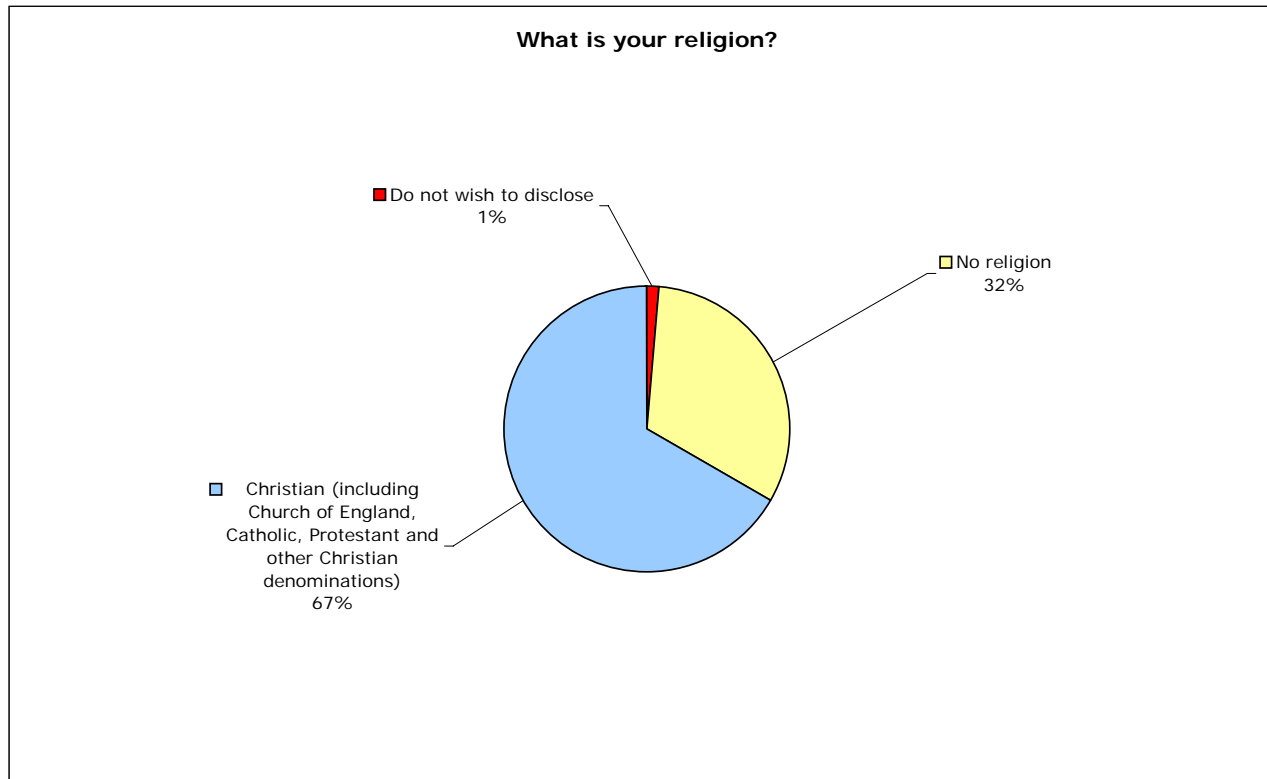
Question 10 was 'How would you describe your sexual orientation?'

99% of respondents specified 'heterosexual'. 1% of respondents specified 'gay'.

No respondents specified bisexual, lesbian or other.

0% of respondents felt that they did not wish to disclose this information.

Question 11: What is your religion?



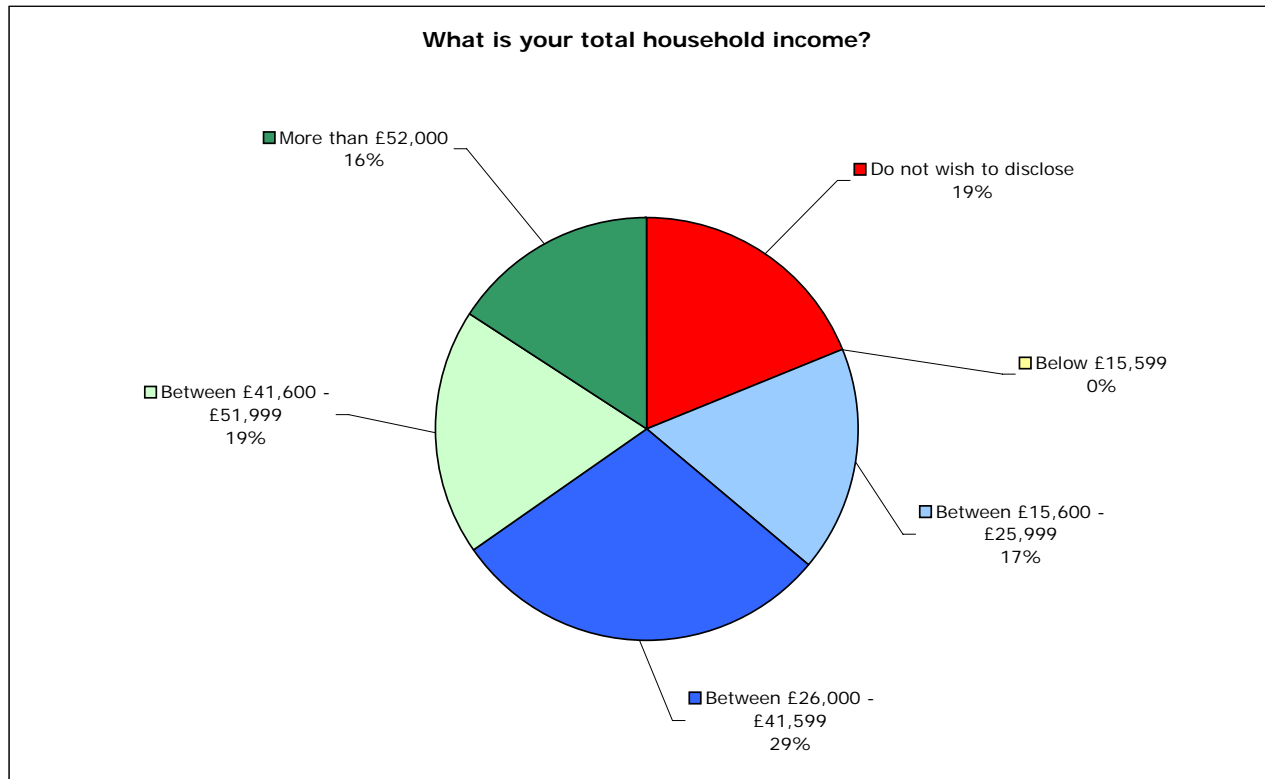
There were a total of 9 options for respondents to specify what their religion was. These were:

- Do not wish to disclose
- No religion
- Christian (including Church of England, Catholic, Protestant and other Christian denominations)
- Buddhist
- Hindu
- Jewish
- Muslim
- Sikh
- Any other religion

67% of respondents specified that they were Christian (including Church of England, Catholic, Protestant and other Christian denominations).

32% of respondents specified that they had no religion, and 1% specified that they did not want to disclose their religion.

Question 12: What is your total household income?



Question 12 was regarding total household income for respondents.

The majority of respondents (29%) specified that their total household income was between £26,000 - £41,599.

17% of respondents specified that their total household income was £15,600 - £25,999. 19% also specified £41,600 - £51,999.

16% of respondents specified their total household income was more than £52,000.

19% also specified that they did not wish to disclose this information.

Location

Respondents were then asked where they lived. They could either specify a postcode or if they wished, just a district.
